Easy to use, Zavlar™ can be applied using a brush, roller or squeegee.



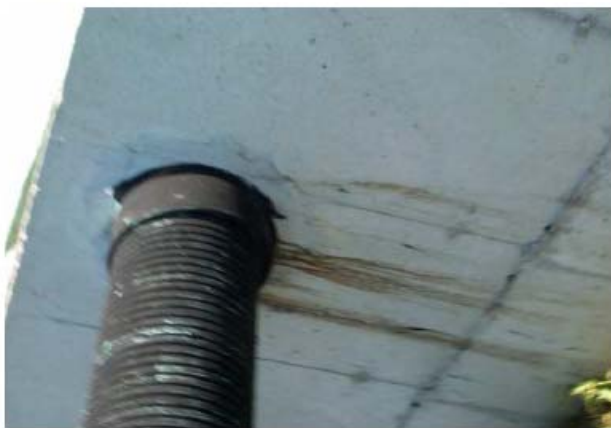

This medium cure feature, allows for geotextile or other reinforcing fabric to be set in the first coat of Zavlar™ and fully saturate prior to curing. This gives an extra strong repair to damaged roofing membranes or larger cracks in concrete.



Sealing around vents, and drains or where pipes pass through concrete or foundation walls requires a sealant that both adheres to the different materials equally well but has sufficient flexibility and elasticity to resist cracking and tearing due structural movement.
